Dear Mayor Buddy Dyer,

Thanks so much for telling the Orlando Sentinel that you are willing to meet with the volunteers of **Orlando Food Not Bombs**. We are happy to accept your invitation to share meals and information at city hall and plan to start providing lunch once a week as soon as possible. Please bring your peppers. We would be honored to add them to our meal.

As you may know the anti -food sharing ordinance is not acceptable. We are happy to work with you but we can not agree to limit our accessibility to the public. Limiting our meals and message to twice a year per park will not work.

This is not the time to limit efforts to change society. Our economy is in crisis and hiding the problem is not a solution. In the world's wealthiest country where over 50 cents of every federal tax dollar is spent on war it is possible to change society so no one is forced to stand in line to eat at a soup kitchen; and all people have nutritious food to prepare in their own kitchen. This message should be expressed loud, often and with as much passion as possible. Moving our meal and message from park to park is not acceptable. **Orlando Food Not Bombs** looks forward to coming to an agreement.

Support for our effort is widespread. Many residence of Lake Eola Heights are attending our meals to show support. People from all over Orlando, the state of Florida, italy, Japan, United Kingdom and many other countries are asking us to continue. We will leave Lake Eola Park as clean or cleaner then we found it just as we have since starting our weekly meals. We also welcome local condominium owners and businesses to join us each week. **Orlando Food Not Bombs** welcomes your participation in our effort to end hunger and poverty.

Orlando Food Not Bombs asks that you:

Implement a moratorium on the arrests of people sharing food at Lake Eola Park.

Repeal Anti-food sharing ordinance 18A.09-2.

Drop the charges of those arrested and lift the trespass orders.

Agree to the group's request to a meeting between the Mayor and Food Not Bombs.

Repeal the ordinances that criminalize poverty in Orlando such as the panhandling zones, horizontal sitting and other laws directed at our poor.

NARRATIVE: The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the, _____ 1 of June 2011 at 6:22 PM at 101 N. ROSALIND AVE (Zone: D-2) in Orange County did

On June 1, 2011 at approximately 1730 hours, the Defendant did knowingly (sponsor, conduct or participate in) the distribution or service of food at a Large Group Feeding at Lake Eola Park, a park facility owned or controlled by the City of Orlando within the Greater Downtown Park District without obtaining a Large Group Feeding Permit issued by the City Director of Families, Parks and Recreation or their designee. This Large Group Feeding, sponsored by Orlando Food Not Bombs, served ___40___ people, which were counted by members of the Orlando Police Department. The Defendant's participation in this Large Group Feeding involved preparing boxes, set up tables and fed participants of the feeding.

On April 25, 2011 at 0900 hours and May 2, 2011 at 0900 hours, Benjamin Markeson, a key member of Orlando Food Not Bombs, applied for Large Group Feeding permits (numbers 11-010-001 and 11-010-001) for feedings conducted at Orlando City Hall, City Hall Commons Plaza, Orlando, Florida; Markeson applied for the permits utilizing the organizational name H.E.A.R.T. On both occasions, Markeson was provided with: copies of the City's Large Group Feeding ordinance, permits for those dates and locations, a list of Greater Orlando Downtown Parks, a map of the Greater Downtown Park District, and a list of other charitable meals available in Downtown Orlando, providing Markeson with knowledge of the City's Large Group Feeding Ordinance.

On May 18 and 23, 2011, Orlando Food Not Bombs, an organization the Defendant is associated with (evidenced by their previous participation in Large Group Feedings with this organization) conducted Large Group Feedings of greater than 25 people at Lake Eola Park. On both dates, Large Group Feeding Permits were issued (numbers 11-062-013 and 11-062-016) at the time of the feedings in person to the organization by the City Director of Families, Parks and Recreation or their designee; this all took place in the presence of members of the Orlando Police Department. Prior to these feedings, Orlando Food Not Bombs published on their public access internet web site a statement calling for members to join at Lake Eola Park to "risk arrest" and conduct a Large Group Feeding without first obtaining a Large Group Feeding Permit; this internet posting indicates Orlando Food Not Bombs' knowledge of the City's Large Group Feeding ordinance and their clear intent to violate the ordinance.

On May 25, 2011, members of the Orlando Police Department observed approximately 40 individuals participating in an illegal Large Group Feeding being conducted by Orlando Food Not Bombs. Prior to this feeding, Orlando Food Not Bombs, an organization which previously conducted Large Group Feedings in which the Defendant participated, published on their public access internet web site a statement calling for members to join them on May 25, 2011 at 1730 hours at Lake Eola Park to "non-violently defy" the City of Orlando's Large Group Feeding ordinance; again, this internet posting indicates Orlando Food Not Bombs' knowledge of the City's Large Group Feeding ordinance and their clear intent to violate the ordinance.

FNB is an activist group which openly protest the war in Iraq and against the activities of the United States and Richmond City governments as well as those of Trani, President of Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU).

Over the past 6 years [redacted] has advocated members of the group to demonstrate in protest of environmental issues, sprawl at VCU and in support of the Palestinian movement. The protests have resulted in vandalism and property damage including spray painting of anarchist symbols on city buildings and broken windows. Over the past three years, damage to sports utility vehicles (SUV) in the City of Richmond have gone unsolved. However, notes left at the scene with environmental explanations and the etching of the letters ELF in the paint of the vehicles appear related to [redacted] teachings.

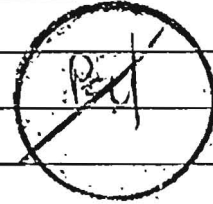

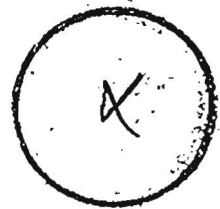

Details: Richmond source provided the following information:

Source attended a Food Not Bombs meeting and the main topic of discussion at this meeting was the one year anniversary of the beginning of the war in Iraq and plans on how to protest the same. [redacted] took the role of leading the meeting and suggested escalating the planned protests from only a Fort Bragg confrontation to an additional and similar plan for the Quantico Virginia Marine Base. The date of action for the plan is March 20, 2004. According to source, up to twenty members of the group have purchased gas masks within the last two weeks and have trained in the use of them for these events. [redacted] also spoke of other Food Not Bombs groups from different cities being involved in the confrontations. Again discussed was the training of members for physical confrontation with either military or local police; however, no definite plans for this were made at the meeting. Members of the group are attempting to secure financing for busing at this time. Members who source could identify by name as actively planning on participating are [redacted]

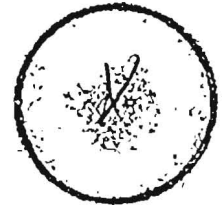

In the early parts of the rally, these subjects attempted to intimidate marchers by their presence, but as the actual march began, the form of intimidation turned verbal and almost physical. The Richmond Police Department interceded before any violence occurred and segregated this group from the marchers for the duration of the event. 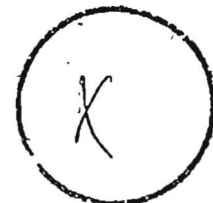

[redacted] was observed at multiple anti-war and living wage rallies, but no criminal activity has been confirmed. [redacted] is still considered a suspect by Virginia State Capitol Police in the February 2004 vandalism of the Robert E. Lee monument, but the accusation has not been proven as of this writing. Due to the lack of association with criminal activities, Richmond considers this case closed.

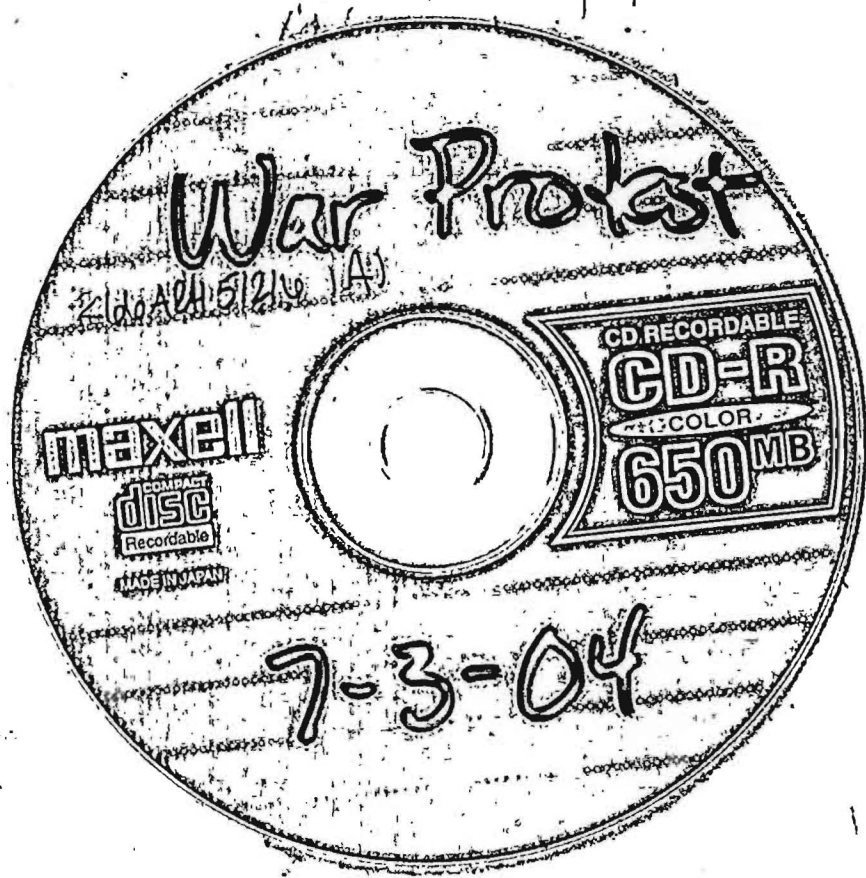
